

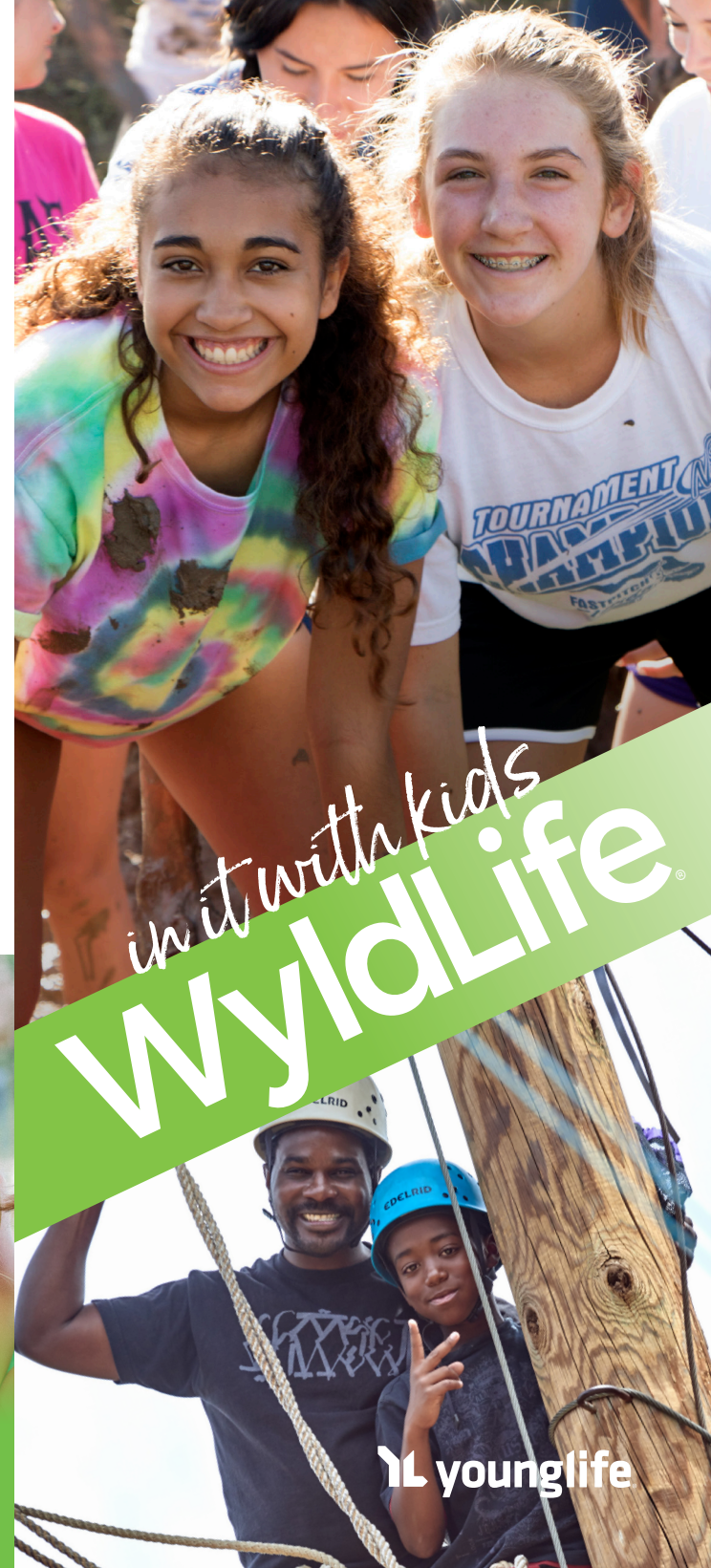


Young Life's Mission
