## CLUB

This is where for an hour each week military teens can put aside the fear and pressures they face and just be kids. It's laughter, fun and a great place to make new friends with other kids who understand military life.

## CAMP

Camp is the opportunity to experience high adventure and belly laughter. It's a safe space where for a week where kids can be themselves, create lasting memories and experience God's love in tangible, transformative ways.

## CAMPAIGNERS

Campaigners is the time during the week when kids and leaders dig deeper in the Bible and discover how God's word encourages them to grow in their faith through study, service and leadership.
